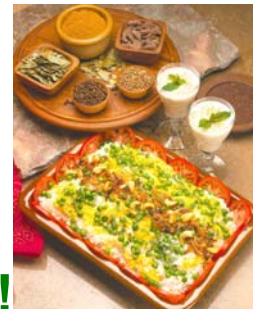
Our classes went well this month, with Robert giving us some practical hints on repairing tube-type radios.

We had a sad time with the passing of Joel's son and mother. Our prayers are with Joel and his family.

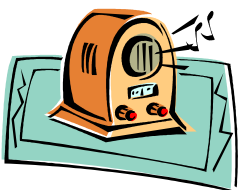
That's it for this month. Come out and help us spend all this money! Seriously, we would value member inputs on ways we can improve our club and honor our founders' desires for preserving the history of radio.
